

## Construction, Engineering, and Inspection Services Solicitation No. 19-117— Addendum #4 May 16. 2019

This Addendum #4 to SRTA Solicitation No. 19-117 is being issued in accordance with Section 2.5 of the Request for Qualifications document. SRTA Solicitation No. 19-117 is hereby amended as follows:

**PART 1-Solicitation Offer and Award, Section 2.2-Format of Qualification Submissions is** hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Submitting firms shall submit qualification submissions to SRTA by either: 1.) providing five (5) hard copies, with one (1) marked "Original" with original signatures **OR** 2.) submitting one (1) electronic copy marked "Original" with original signatures via email to the Issuing Officer. Digital signatures are acceptable as original signatures. The electronic copy must be submitted in Portable Document Format (PDF), Microsoft Word, and/or Microsoft Excel formats and shall contain electronic file copies of all complete, signed Offer Documents and required documentation. In the event of a discrepancy between an Original hard copy and an electronic copy submitted by a firm, the Original hard copy shall control.

All qualifications submissions must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the submission format and content requirements specified in the RFQ. Qualification submissions must be typed. The included required forms may be completed by using the free Adobe Reader software available at <a href="http://get.adobe.com/reader/">http://get.adobe.com/reader/</a>. As a condition of submission responsiveness, all Offer Documents that require the signature of an authorized representative of the submitted firm must be signed. Any Contract award made as a result of this solicitation shall bind the successful firm to all of the terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this RFQ.

Use caution in creating electronic files to be submitted to SRTA. If SRTA is unable to open an electronic file due to a virus or because the file has become corrupted, the firm's response may be considered incomplete and disqualified from further consideration. In the event of a conflict between the electronic copy and the hard copy, the "Original" hard copy shall control.

SRTA shall not be responsible for qualification submissions that are sent via email and are not received by SRTA until after the Statement of Qualification Submission Deadline due to technical issues. It is the solely the responsibility of the submitting firm to ensure that its qualification submission is received by SRTA by the Statement of Qualification Submission Deadline.

All other terms and conditions of SRTA Solicitation No. 19-117 not specifically addressed in this Addendum #4 remain in full force and effect.
